

**HON'BLE GOVERNOR OF TAMILNADU & CHANCELLOR PRESIDED
OVER THE 12TH CONVOCATION OF THE TAMIL NADU DR.AMBEDKAR
LAW UNIVERSITY (TNDALU) AND CONFERRED DEGREES AND
MEDALS TO STUDENTS AT CHENNAI, TODAY (02.12.2022)**

Hon'ble Governor of Tamil Nadu & Chancellor, Thiru.R.N.Ravi presided over the 12th Convocation of The Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University and conferred degrees and medals to students at Chennai, today (02.12.2022).

Hon'ble Governor in his presidential address, underscored the greater role of the young law graduates in the ongoing resurgence of the Nation. Narendra Modi has for Tamil language and literature.
